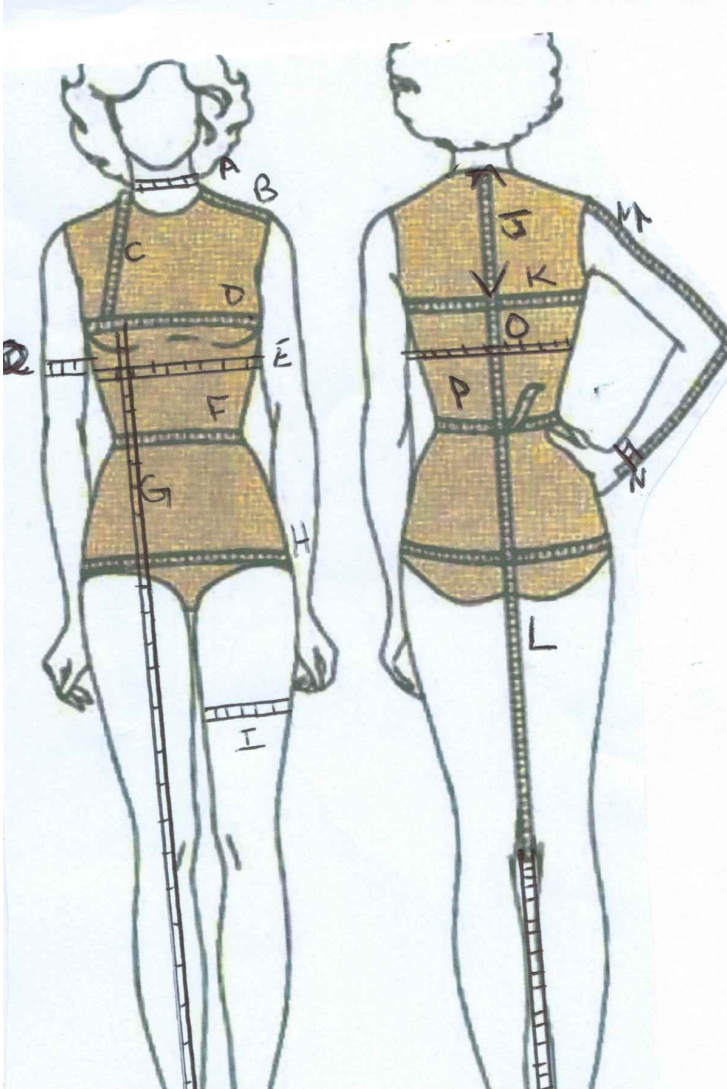




## Mrs Papendick, Historical Seamstress

### Measurement chart



Height \_\_\_\_\_

A) Neck circumference \_\_\_\_\_

B) Shoulder \_\_\_\_\_

C) Shoulder to nipple \_\_\_\_\_

D) Bust circumference \_\_\_\_\_

E) Empire line (around the chest under the bust. It is a good idea to follow the bottom of where your bra sits) \_\_\_\_\_

F) Waist - measured where you bend. \_\_\_\_\_

G) Skirt length (measured from the empire line that you have just measured to the required length, usually to the top of your foot so you do not trip) \_\_\_\_\_

H) Hip circumference \_\_\_\_\_

I) Thigh \_\_\_\_\_

J) Nape of neck to line K \_\_\_\_\_

K) Arm to arm with arms pressed closely to your side. (In other words do not go around actually into the armpit.) \_\_\_\_\_

L) Full length nape to floor \_\_\_\_\_

M) Arm measured to desired length. If long sleeves or 3/4 are required please measure with arm bent. \_\_\_\_\_

N) Wrist \_\_\_\_\_

O) Nape to empire line \_\_\_\_\_

P) Nape to waist \_\_\_\_\_

Q) Bicep circumference \_\_\_\_\_
